**Coming to Campus? Safety Comes First!
Ask Yourself These Questions**

Passaic County Community College is working to provide a safe campus environment for students, employees, and visitors. The College has established the following procedures and practices which must be followed by all individuals before coming on campus.

DAILY HEALTH SCREENING SELF-ASSESSMENT		
DO NOT come to campus if you answered YES to any of the following questions:	YES	NO
1. Do you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher now?		
2. Have you had a temperature of 100.4 or higher in the last 48 hours?		
3. Have you been in close contact with someone who has a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19? Per CDC guidelines, close contact means being closer than six feet apart for 10 minutes or more.		
4. Are you currently experiencing any of the following symptoms that are not related to an underlying or existing condition: cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat?		
5. Are you experiencing a new loss of taste or smell?		
6. Within the last 24 hours, have you experienced gastrointestinal or digestive issues (nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea) that are not related to any underlying condition(s)?		
7. Have you recently flown on an airplane?		
8. Have you or has anyone you live with traveled internationally during the previous 14 days?		
9. Have you or has anyone you live with traveled to a COVID 19 hotspot in the United States the previous 14 days? To find the most current list of “hot spots” in the US go to https://covid19.nj.gov/
